HAMMOND BAY BAPTIST CHURCH "CONSTITUTION"

ARTICLE I. - NAME

The name of the society is the "Hammond Bay Baptist Church".

ARTICLE II. - PURPOSE

A. The members of this society band together under the expressed commission by the Lord Jesus Christ to "make disciples of all nations" Matthew 28:19.

This involves:

- 1. EVANGELISM proclaiming the gospel in word and in action, with the intent to persuade people at home and globally to a personal commitment to Christ:
- 2. EDUCATION teaching the truths and the requirements of the Word of God and training its members to serve the interests of Christ and His Church with their gifts, abilities and resources:
- 3. EXALTATION gathering together for the public worship of God and for the observance of the ordinances.
- 4. EDIFICATION gathering together formally and informally in small numbers for fellowship intended for the spiritual nurture and encouragement of one another.
- B. To secure by purchase or gift, title to property, real or personal, as may be utilize to further the objectives of the Society;
- C. To solicit, collect and invest monies and other property for the furtherance of the objectives of the Society;
- D. To cooperate with the British Columbia Baptist Conference and the Baptist General Conference of Canada in their Canadian and global mission.
